Road Safety Week

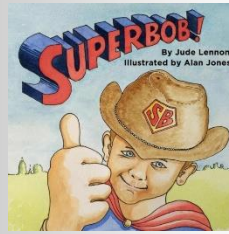
Week beginning Monday 8th October is Road Safety week.
