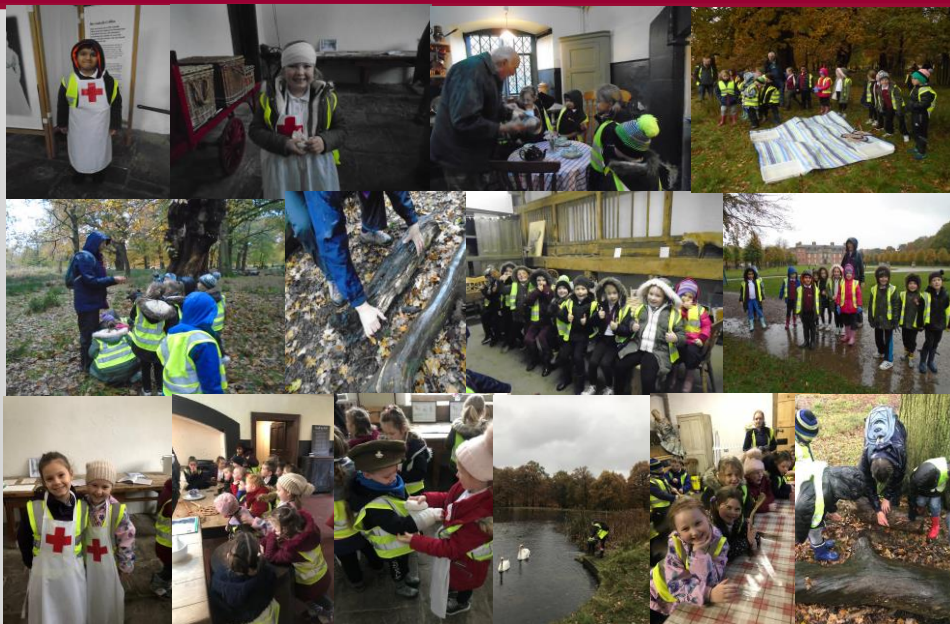
Shoes: Please make sure your child is in appropriate footwear for school and in accordance with the school uniform policy. Trainers and boots are not allowed.
