Welcome to Nursery.

We have a fun packed half term ahead.

Here is a quick summary of what we will be covering and if you would like to find out more about what and how your child will be learning this year then please ask any member of the Nursery staff!

This half term our Topic is Space.

We will be looking at Space and discussing how we may get there.

We will be reading books to find out more about space and what life may be like on other planets! We will also continue to explore the Season of Autumn, looking at the changes that take place in our environment and learning some Autumn inspired songs and rhymes.



This half term we will be focusing on comparing sizes.

We will compare different objects to see if we can identify which object may be smaller or larger.

We will continue to recite numbers 1 to 5, and looking at how many objects are associated with each number.

Phonics – We will continue with daily phonics sessions focusing on listening. We will learn to listen out for sounds around our local environment.



In Language this half term, we will start our 'Talk for Writing' programme of work. We will focus on the key texts 'The Way Back Home' and 'Whatever Next'. Using these books we will learn to retell stories using props, actions and story maps

We will work on our cutting skills when in the creative area. We will be developing our motor-skills by taking part in dough disco activities.

Please ensure your child/ren are wearing school shoes to Nursery.

Just a reminder that bows and earrings are not permitted in school.

On a Friday children can bring in one small item of interest /toy to be discussed in class.

Library books and reading books will be changed once a week. Please sign your child's planner when you have read with them and please make sure that book bags are brought in each day.
