Welcome to back to Nursery, we hope you had a lovely Christmas and New Year!

Here is a quick summary of what we will be covering this half term.

Library books

Every Friday your child will be asked to choose a book to take home. Please read this book to your child and talk about the story with them . Please bring the book back the following week to be changed.



We will be continuing to learn how to count using one-to-one correspondence, making sure that we count each object without missing it out. We will be learning to securely recognise numbers 1-5 and extending to recognise to 10.

We will be continuing to name 2 D shapes and recognise shapes around the environment.

Please can you encourage your child to see 2 D shapes around your house.



In Language this half term, we will be learning about 'Elmer the Elephant'. We will be recalling stories and talking about the characters in the books. We will be linking our other areas of learning to Elmer as well as our topic of 'Around the World'.

Phonics — We will continue with our daily phonics sessions. We will be learning our about rhyming words and encouraging children to hear the first sound of words. CVC words. Please encourage your children to develop this skill at home by playing games such as eye spy.

Please remember to label all personal items including jumpers, coats water bottles and book bags.
