With Covid regulations changing again this week we will continue to publish information to keep the guidance fresh in your mind. In Greater Manchester we have been placed in Tier 2 which is considered a high alert level. Please check your Schooling messages regularly for any changes or updates.

Over the course of this half term the children have been working on our 'recovery curriculum' to support them in catching up on their lost learning. After half term, we will reassess the children to identify how they have progressed and find out any areas that remain a weakness.
