Welcome to Nursery.

We have a fun packed half term ahead.

Here is a quick summary of what we will be covering and if you would like to find out more about what and how your child will be learning this year then please ask any member of the Nursery staff!

School starts at 8.45AM



This half term our Topic is 'Space and Celebrations'.

We will be looking at 'Bonfire Night' and discussing the importance of being safe with fireworks. We will be learning about Space and reading books to find out more about space and what life may be like on other planets! We will also be learning about Remembrance day, Diwali and Children in need.



This half term we will be focusing on comparing sizes.

We will compare different objects to see if we can identify which object may be smaller or larger.

We will continue to recite numbers 1 to 5, and looking at how many objects are associated with each number.

Phonics — We begin daily phonics sessions focusing on listening skills. We will learn to listen out for sounds around our local environment as well as developing our Knowledge of Nursery rhymes.



In Language this half term, we will focus on the key texts ' *Whatever Next* ', ' *Look inside Space* ', ' *Stickman* ' and ' *The Nativity story* '. Using these books we will learn to retell stories, learn repetitive phases as well as learning about rhyming words.
