

During the workshop the children will have the opportunity to take part in lots of activities. This workshop will be used as a hook to introduce the children to our Spring term history topic.


The cost of the workshop to yourselves is £5. This needs to be paid on Parent Pay by Thursday 7th January 2021. Thank you.
