Welcome to Nursery.

We have a fun packed half term ahead.

Here is a quick summary of what we will be covering and if you would like to find out more about what and how your child will be learning this year then please ask any member of the Nursery staff!



This half term our Topic is ***Ourselves***

We will be talking about Our Families and different ages and stages in our lives.

Our interests and likes for example foods, colours, toys, pets, books etc.

We will be looking at our bodies and our senses

We will also be thinking about 'People who help us' – dentist, doctors, opticians etc.

We will also learn about Harvest, Autumn and Halloween.



This half term we will be focusing on matching, sorting and comparing amounts in maths time and when exploring the environment. We will also be exploring pattern.



Phonics—

We will begin daily phonics sessions focusing on listening skills. We will learn to listen for sounds around our local environment. We will also explore different ways of making sounds

We will be learning to sing a variety of Nursery Rhymes.

On hot days please bring sun hats and apply sun cream to your child before coming to Nursery.

Please encourage your child to wash their hands in the outside sinks before entering the Nursery building



We will be reading stories that relate to the theme "Ourselves" for example Goldilocks and the 3 Bears, The Gingerbread Man, The Three Little Pigs, The Three Billy Goats Gruff, Information books about our bodies, The Little Red Hen, Owl Babies, Red Rockets and Rainbow Jelly, There's a Snake in my school, Paw Patrol books, Pepper pig books, Funny Bones books, Meg and Mog books, Room on the Broom and Pumpkin soup.

If you could read some of these books at home with your child it would support their learning in school.

Please remember to label all personal items such as jumpers and coats

Please bring your child's planner into Nursery. Important notes will be written in these daily. If you would like to buy a burgundy book bag to keep the planner in you can purchase these from the office or from the Petite Mode website.

Just a reminder that bows and earrings are not permitted in school.

If you have a spare water bottle at home that your child could leave at school until the end of half term then please could you bring it in labelled. Otherwise water bottles will be provided.
