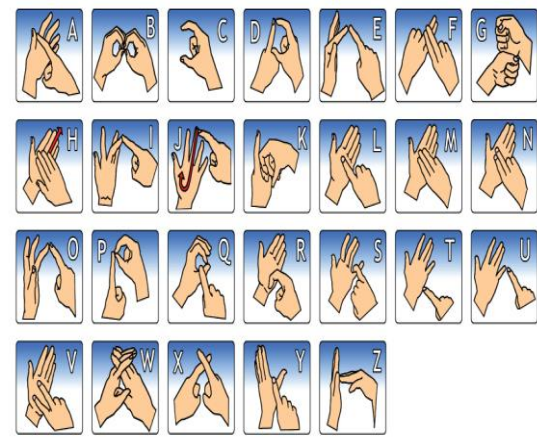

We talked about the different ways in which humans can communicate without speaking, such as using body language and gesture, facial expressions and making sounds. We also discussed reasons why sign language is used as not all signers are hearing impaired. The winner of Strictly Come Dancing '21 was Eastenders actor Rose Ayling - Ellis. She is deaf and uses British Sign Language (BSL). We watched a video of Rose dancing to the song Symphony with her partner Giovanni. The silent break in the music, whilst the couple carried on dancing, helped us imagine what it must feel like to not be able to hear. Next week we are going to learn the signs to the song Symphony by Clean Bandit & Zara Larson.
