The Dental Nurse visited the Early Year's children. They learned how to clean their teeth properly and what foods and drinks they should eat to keep their teeth healthy.

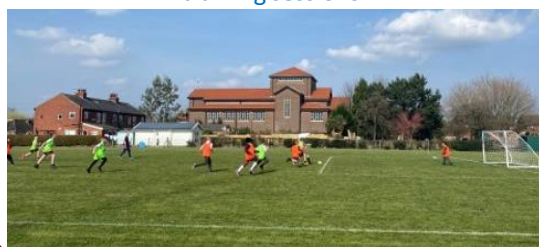

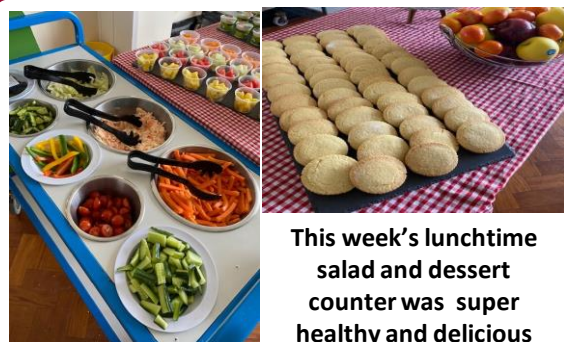
