This half term we will be looking at topics such as 'Our home', 'Polar regions', 'Hot countries such as Kenya', 'Healthy children', 'Jack and the beanstalk', 'Life cycles' and Easter.



This half term we will be focusing on counting 1-5.

We will be reciting numbers 1 to 5, and looking at how many objects are associated with each number.

Phonics

We will be continuing with our daily phonic sessions focusing on hearing rhyming words, initial sounds, blending and segmenting words.

Literacy

This half term we be focusing on improving our mark making skills. We will be continuing to practice writing our names.
