## Welcome back to Nursery!

We hope you all had a lovely Easter break! Thank you to those parents that uploaded pictures of what your child has been up to during the holiday. We had a lovely class discussion about the pictures.

Here is a quick summary of what we will be covering and if you would like to find out more about what and how your child will be learning this year then please ask any member of the Nursery staff!



This half term we will be focusing on counting 1-5.

We will be reciting numbers 1 to 5, and looking at how many objects are associated with each number.

## Phonics—

We will be introducing our with our read write inc scheme . We will be introducing 2 sounds to the children each week starting with 'm' and 'a'. We will send home mark making sheets each week for your child to practice forming the letters correctly. We will also be continuing to encourage listening skills— hearing the initial sound of words and encouraging blending and segmenting skills.

## Literacy

We will be introducing 'talk through stories' and each week focusing on one story, We will be encouraging the children to learn the key vocabulary and have good understanding of the comprehension of the text. Texts we will be focusing on include 'The very hungry caterpillar', 'Farmer duck', 'Click clack Moo' and 'What the ladybird heard'

This half term we will be looking at mini-beasts and farm animals.

Please bring a labelled water bottle to school each day with just water in and no juice. Thank you!



Please ensure your child is practicing to write their name frequently. This will really help them when they start Re-

Just a reminder that bows and earrings are not permitted in school.

Please ensure your child is wearing sun cream on days when the weather is hot and also bring a sun hat for your child to wear when playing outside.
