In English, this half term, we will focus on poems and will write our own based upon a wizard or witch. We will learn how to use the possessive apostrophe in our SPaG lessons and then apply this knowledge into our own poem.

This term there is a heavy focus on spelling, grammar and punctuation as we move closer to the SATs, we will be revising and revisiting suffixes, verbs, nouns and the four sentence types.


We will also be providing additional sessions to support the children's reading and comprehension skills leading into the assessment period.

Year 2 children will be completing their end of Key Stage 1 SATs assessments throughout May. Please support your children throughout this period by ensuring they are getting plenty of sleep, having a balanced breakfast to start the day and are attending school everyday on time ready to start!



In maths, the children will develop their understanding of measuring length and height using centimetres and metres. This will then enable them to compare different lengths/ heights and problem solve with their measurement skills. We will then start learning about position and direction where the children will become familiar with terms such as anti-clockwise/clockwise, half/quarter and full turn.

Our science work this half term focuses on learning about animals and lifecycles and what humans and animals need to survive.

If your child has milk please note that this is now paid for on Parent Pay.



Important Information Weekly homework will consist of::
