Welcome back!


Welcome back to school. We hope you all had a restful break. Year 5 would especially love to win the attendance awards this year, so see you bright and early!

We would like to take the opportunity to let you know about some of the things we will be learning about this half term.

Our topic in History is one of the most fascinating of periods in the history of our country—the Tudors and Stuarts. Beginning with the defeat of Richard III by Henry Tudor at the Battle of Bosworth in 1485 and ending with Queen Anne in 1714 it has everything from the Golden Age to plague, fire and civil war in it.



In English, our learning will be led by our class text 'Treason' by Berlie Doherty.



We will be writing to entertain. At the end of the unit will be writing a poem about London in Tudor times.

In Maths, we will focus on decimals. The children will develop their knowledge of adding and subtracting decimals. Children will be learning how to multiply and divide decimals by 10, 100 and 1000.

We will also take part in lots of lessons in other subjects such as Art, Geography, ICT, P.E, RE, PSHE, Music and Spanish.
