In the news this week

A housing association has built Europe's first virtually plastic-free housing development in the UK. Built by Greedopment Accord, the 71 project in Greedop and the Accord, the 71 project in 12 affordable one-bedroom homes built using plastic-free alternatives to reduce environmental impact. Each apartment features many alternatives, such as wooden kitchen units and aluminium window frames. The wiring uses a mineral-based insulation rather than the usual plastic, and solar thermal heating systems are also installed.
