Welcome back! We trust you enjoyed the Easter holidays and had a restful break.

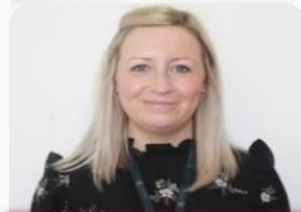
This term we have the Y6 SATs. It is essential children in Y6 are in school every day as we approach the tests as time is very limited. Y6 SATs week is **Tues 9th May to Fri 12th May**. Children need to be in school every day during SATs week to complete their national assessments and this is the only time they are allowed to take them. Papers will be sent off immediately after the tests take place and results return in July. During this week, Y6 pupils should make sure they are organised and have lots of sleep. They should revise as much as possible using their CGP books and online passwords. We will ask the Y6 children to come in earlier during SATs week to offer them breakfast, give them last minute reminders and calm any nerves.

Y2 will also have SATs this term and they will take place the w/b 15th May. These assessments are less formal and done in smaller groups. The results of these tests will be used to inform teacher judgements on whether the pupils are at the expected standards for their age. Results will be shared with families after they have been submitted to the local authority at the end of the school year.

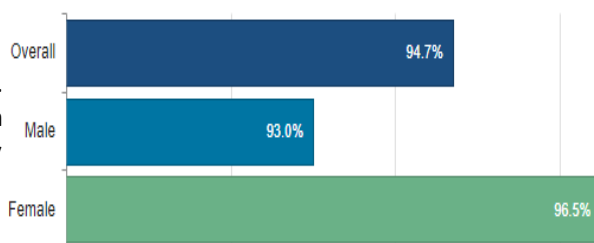

Attendance: High attendance is a key priority for all children in our school. We have an aspirational target of 97% for all our children. Currently we have an attendance rate of 93.5% for this school year so far and we hope we can continue to improve this. This week our best attenders have been in Y2 (Well done Y2!) with Y5 and Y1 very close behind. Our highest absences have occurred in Y4 this week. This week overall, our attendance rate is 94.7% with girls attendance much better than the boys. Please remember that if you're unsure whether your child is poorly you can always speak to our staff who will offer advice on whether they should be in school. We will always ring you if they become poorly in school. Holidays in term time **will not** be authorised and parents **will receive** a penalty notice. Penalty notices are £60 per child for each parent. Attendance is particularly crucial for Y6 and Y2 currently as they begin their SATs tests.
