Huge congratulations to the Y4 staff and pupils on their efforts to learn their multiplication tables this year. The children have recently completed their national multiplication checks. These checks test pupils on the speed and accuracy of answering 25 multiplication questions. Our Year 4 children performed brilliantly and 81% achieved a score of 20 or more out of 25, with 47% of pupils achieving full marks! Well done Year 4! Fantastic results.

Further congratulations for our Year 1 team who have worked relentlessly with our Y1 children this year to support our children in phonics. The children have now completed their national phonics screening checks and 77% of pupils met the expected standard. This is a fantastic achievement and progress has been very strong this year. All children have made very good progress and this places them in an excellent position to read fluently as they get ready to enter Year 2. Well done to all those involved in teaching phonics groups and to the children for working so hard to achieve these results. Well done Year 1!
