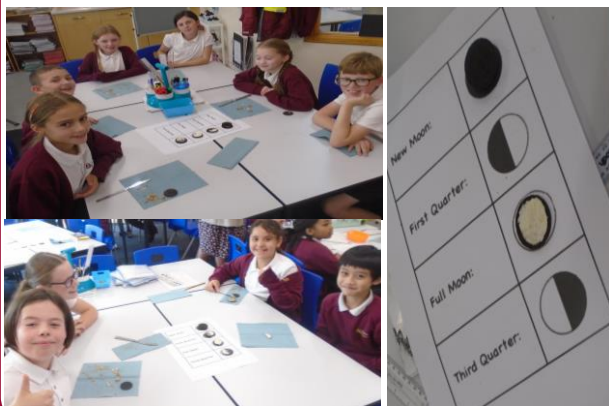
**Year 5 Science**
