

### Welcome Back!

We hope that you've had a wonderful break and are looking forward to the new academic year!

This half term we will Embark on a number of fact-finding missions.



Firstly, we will be learning about the Victorians and exploring the ways in which life in Britain has changed in the last 200 years. We will explore the rise of technology and the many implications of the discoveries made in the Victorian era, focusing on how our lives are affected by them today.

In Science, we will be taking a step further by learning about electricity and light—two things which were harnessed and greatly improved during the Victorian era.

In English, we will be producing biographical texts and newspaper reports as we develop our nonfiction writing and research skills.



In Year 6, as in previous years, we expect that **homework is completed by** <u>everyone</u>. This is non-negotiable and if it is not completed, children will be expected to finish it at lunchtime on the due day.

Reading homework remains nonnegotiable and should be completed, at the very least, three times each week. When you listen to your child read, please make sure to sign their planner and leave us a comment about their reading - this partnership really helps us to structure your child's learning and identify their areas of need.
