## **Headteacher Comment**

We continue to focus on attendance and punctuality as key areas. The vast majority of our children have excellent attendance and attend school on time every day. Many of our children have 100% attendance. We are looking to improve the attendance of some children, particularly those who fall below 90%. If your child has attendance of 90% or less then they are classed as a 'persistent absentees' by national standards. We find that holidays in term time impact on this significantly and also those children who regularly have odd days off. Children who have low level symptoms such as headaches, coughs and colds should still be in school. We will always contact families if a child becomes poorly during the school day. First response calls are made daily to parents who have not informed the office of their child's reason for absence. If contact cannot be made then home visits and welfare checks are made. Holidays in term time receive penalty notices and these are also issued to those with too many unauthorised absences. Good attendance is key to a happy school life and it prevents emerging gaps in learning. We want each pupil to have the best opportunities and enjoy the full experience of school with their teachers and friends. Wishing you all a lovely weekend. See you Monday!
