## Headteacher Comment

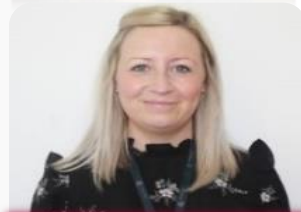
