On Friday 2nd February we will be celebrating Times Table Rockstars by dressing up as musicians. We will use the day to promote maths throughout the school. Children will complete maths challenges and activities. It will also be used to remind children about accessing their Times Tables Rock Stars accounts and practising at home. Times Tables Rock Stars is a fun, online learning platform which helps children to recall their times tables at speed. It adapts according to the child's level of ability. Children who access Times Table Rock Stars demonstrate improved fluency and recall in both multiplication and division. They also show increased confidence during maths lessons. Please actively support your child in accessing TTRS on devices at home. Log-in details are in their planners. If you cannot find your child's log-in details then please don't hesitate to contact the class teacher.
