


#### Headteacher Urgent Message:

Every week for the last 3 weeks we have had to deal with the aftermath of children using social media inappropriately. Parents are frequently requesting that school staff resolve issues that have happened outside of school and over social media. I cannot stress enough that parental controls should be put on devices. Parents should also ensure that daily checks are made so that activity is monitored closely. Inappropriate language and incidents of children arranging to 'gang up' on others is increasing. Parents must put boundaries and guidelines in place for their children when using social media. The NSPCC recommend that no one under the age of 16 uses WhatsApp and 13+ for Tiktok.
