Headteacher Comment

This week I spent some time with the Reception children who were taking part in a reading lesson. It was incredible to see how well the children were doing and the way that they engaged in their learning so fully. The enthusiasm of the teachers was infectious and every child made progress. Children focused intently on the tasks they were undertaking and showed excellent learning behaviours by making sure they were watching, listening and taking part. It was particularly enjoyable to watch them working with partners to support each other's reading and to see them using their phonics to help them read sentences. It was an absolute delight to be part of their learning. Well done, Reception!

Y6 children move into their last phase of revision ready for their SATs assessments. The tests take place **Mon 13th May – Thurs 16th May**. These are statutory tests that all Y6 children across the country will be participating in to check that they are at the expected standard by the time they leave primary education. 
